



**ATTENTION CLASS OF 2011 and after:**

**According to Florida Statue 1009.534, For student to receive the Florida Academic Scholars award in the Bright Futures program,** a student must complete a program of community service work, which shall include a minimum of 75 hours of service work and require the student to identify a **social problem** that interests him or her, develop a plan for his or her personal involvement in addressing the problem, and, through papers, evaluate and reflect upon his or her experience.

For each service performed (not each time you logged hours for the same activity), the student must complete the following activities by writing neatly, grammatically correct, and coherently. If this is not completed in its entirety, service hours may not be awarded.

**What is the social problem you are addressing in this activity and why does it interest you?**

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**What was your plan to help address this social issue?**

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**What did learn from this experience and what do you think that you could have done better?**
