## **Kid's College @ HCC for students ages 7-12**

This is a summer program offered by the office of Continuing Education at HCC. Their goal is to help stimulate and develop student interests. Kid's College is held at the Corporate Training Center on Davis Island near downtown Tampa in a self-contained building that includes classrooms and labs. *Courses include but are not limited: etiquette, finances, conversational Spanish, Journaling, Bible Trivia, Being an author, First aid, Physics, health & beauty, conversational French, functional math, and creative crafts.*
