LIBRARY NEWS



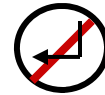

### **Kid's College @ HCC for students ages 7-12**

This is a summer program offered by the office of Continuing Education at HCC. Their goal is to help stimulate and develop student interests. Kid's College is held at the Corporate Training Center on Davis Island near downtown Tampa in self-contained building that includes classrooms and labs. *Courses include but are not limited: etiquette , finances, conversational Spanish, Journaling, Bible Trivia, Being an author, First aid, Physics, health & beauty, conversational French, functional math, and creative crafts.*

Students can choose areas of interest from a variety of classes offered for grades 1-3 and 4-7. The cost is \$75 a week for a morning or afternoon session and \$125 a week for full day courses. Dates and times are available of the program website
