The track team competed at the district meet last week at Indian Rocks Christian, and had several qualify for regionals. In the 4x800, each team member runs two laps around the track (1/2 mile each). In a thrilling boys 4x800 race, Brian Fearnow got the relay baton trailing the 4<sup>th</sup> place anchor leg of Calvary Christian by over 150 meters, but was able to beat him at the finish line by seven tenths of a second, while running it in 2 minutes and ten seconds to give SCA the final qualifying place for regionals.
