EXAM INFO

One of the biggest challenges we face during exam week involves liability. Students are coming and going throughout the exam week, so we wanted to provide you with the following information concerning exam week procedures:

- 1) If a student does not have an exam at the 7:50-9:50 time and they are on campus, they must sign out before leaving. For example, if your child does not have @ 7:50 exam and he/she is meeting friends for breakfast during that time, they need to meet at the restaurant and not on campus. If they are on campus at anytime, we are then responsible for them from a supervision standpoint.
- 2) **Students will be required to remain in class for the entire exam period.** They are not permitted to sign out and leave until after the exam period has ended. The reasoning behind this policy is that we do not want the students rushing through their exam. We want them to take their time and do well, as the exams count as 20% of their semester grade.
- 3) Students who do not have an exam in an elective class are not required to come to school during the exam period. They are required to sign in, however, when they do get on campus.

Thanks for your help in these matters. We hope you understand that we are not trying to be difficult. We just want to make sure we are providing sufficient supervision during this busy time and your kids are where you assume they are supposed to be. CONGRATULATIONS TO SCA STUDENTS

Congratulations to Stephanie Clark, Stephanie Engdahl, Sohaila Ghaisarzadeh, Luke Larsen and Mona Noble for achieving the rank of black belt. All students going into 7th grade for the 2010-2011 school year will need to update their immunization records. All 7th grade students need to have the Hepatitis B series, and they will need a **Tdap** Booster. Please check with your physician to be sure that students are up to date. Students will not be allowed to start school unless immunizations are current.

Students entering K5 will need to have an updated immunization records and a new physical, also all students entering K5 & 1st grade are now required to have a 2nd chicken pox shot.

Parents you may also want to check with your physician about a new Meningitis vaccination that has been made available.

Congratulations to Corey DeHate who successfully tested for red collar which denotes instructor trainee. He demonstrated proficiency in all the material while performing under close scrutiny by no less that 4 black belts.
