### 2011 DATE CHANGES FOR SPRING BREAK

As you might have heard, Hillsborough County public schools have changed their Spring Break date to April 25-29. Therefore, we are going to move ours to match theirs. Please make this change on your calendars.

### EXAM INFO

One of the biggest challenges we face during exam week involves liability. Students are coming and going throughout the exam week, so we wanted to provide you with the following information concerning exam week procedures:

- 1) If a student does not have an exam at the 7:50-9:50 time and they are on campus, they must sign out before leaving. For example, if your child does not have a 7:50 exam and he/she is meeting friends for breakfast during that time, they need to meet at the restaurant and not on campus. If they are on campus at anytime, we are then responsible for them from a supervision standpoint.
- 2) **Students will be required to remain in class for the entire exam period.** They are not permitted to sign out and leave until after the exam period has ended. The reasoning behind this policy is that we do not want the students rushing through their exam. We want them to take their time and do well, as the exams count as 20% of their semester grade.
- 3) Students who do not have an exam in an elective class are not required to come to school during the exam period. They are required to sign in, however, when they do get on campus.

Thanks for your help in these matters. We hope you understand that we are not trying to be difficult. We just want to make sure we are providing sufficient supervision during this busy time and your kids are where you assume they are supposed to be. ## FOOTBALL TEAM PERFORMS WELL IN SCA'S FIRST SPRING GAME!

The SCA Football team played well in their first ever Spring Game last Thursday against Seven Rivers Christian. The game was close throughout, but Seven Rivers ended up prevailing 42-26. Several players had big games. QB Bradley Moorner was 4-8 for 180 yards and threw 3 touchdown passes. TE Garrett Saunders caught the first TD pass in SCA history and ended up catching 3 passes for 131 yards and 2 touchdowns. RB/WR Tanner Richardson returned a kick-off 82 yards for a touchdown, and also caught a 49-yard touchdown pass; he also rushed 4 times for 65 yards. Fullback Seth Lewis rushed 9 times for 49 yards.



## MEDICAL UPDATES



All students going into 7th grade for the 2010-2011 school year will need to update their immunization records. All 7th grade students need to have the Hepatitis B series, and they will need a **Tdap** Booster. Please check with your physician to be sure that students are up to date. Students will not be allowed to start school unless immunizations are current.

Students entering K5 will need to have an updated immunization records and a new physical, also all students entering K5 & 1st grade are now required to have a 2nd chicken pox shot.

Parents you may also want to check with your physician about a new Meningitis vaccination that has been made available.

## ATTENTION ALL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS PLANNING TO TAKE ENGLISH HONORS NEXT YEAR
