Cross Country Update

Congratulations to the Boys Cross Country team for taking home the Class 1A District 5 Runner-up trophy at the district meet last Thursday. The team knocked off favorite Lakeland Christian at the meet, and finished just 18 points behind winner Shorecrest Prep. Michael Oquendo (13th) and Andrew Davis (14th) also qualified for Regionals as individuals by finishing in the top 15, with times of 18:21 and 18:25 respectively. Michael Oquendo's time also broke the old school record held previously by Brian Fearnow. Also finishing impressive were Robbie Fearnow (16th place) in 18:29 and Brian Fearnow (19th place) in 18:38. Grant Dohrenwend also set a personal record in a time of 19:31. The Girls team also did well with Haley Traylor breaking the school record in a time of 22:24. Alexis Bright was right behind her in a time of 22:34. seniors Madison Henline and Amanda Gonzalez finished off their careers well in times of 24:02 and 25:01 respectively.

The Boys team will move on to Regionals this Friday, November 13 at Taylor Park in Largo, with a chance to move on to state! The team will race at 10:45am
