

Dear SCA Parent,

We are excited to kick off our annual fall school fundraising event, The Helping Hands Project! The goal of this event is to raise significant dollars for our school and increase our school's community exposure.

The purpose is three-fold:

1. To encourage and foster the development of a servant's heart in the lives of our students.
2. To raise significant dollars to assist in the continued enhancement and improvement of our educational program.
3. To be an encouragement and testimony to our community and surrounding areas.

Your role in making this project a success is very simple. Please fill out the sponsorship forms provided using family members, friends, Christmas mailing list, doctors, dentists or business associates that might be willing to sponsor your child as they complete their service project. We hope to raise \$90,000 this year to help us with several projects around school: safety improvements, classroom enhancements, and playground upgrades. This event is like a walk-a-thon; but instead of walking around a track we are going to help people in our community.

1. Each student will be asked to complete sponsor forms. These forms will be enclosed in a packet along with instructions of how to fill in each form. The forms are a two-sided mailer to inform the sponsor of the purpose of this event.
2. Complete your portion of the forms and return them to the school for mailing. These forms double as a response form to mail back to the school with a donation in your child's name. **SCA will fold, post, and mail your sponsor forms.**
3. Please note this event is not intended for door to door or person to person solicitation. You simply fill out the forms, and return them to the office!

*If you would not like to complete forms*, but still want your student to receive the incentives, you may pay \$200 per child to represent completed forms, and receive all incentive level rewards. Please return unused forms to the front office.

We want to be a blessing in our community and help our students develop a servant's heart. We will send home all the materials you need to make this a successful event. Remember, the service project is intended for the community, not for the individuals who sponsor your child. We are not charging the people we help on the day of the service project. The money raised during this event will help us with several projects around school. Please feel free to contact the school office with any questions.
