Seffner Christian Academy opened its doors in 1983 to the Tampa Bay area and has provided academic excellence for over 30 years. SCA quickly grew to over 700 students in K-2 - 12th grade. SCA is a ministry of First Free Will Baptist Church, and is supported many other churches, parents and members of the community. SCA is committed to providing a distinctively Christian program while providing an education that is challenging and relevant to the 21st century learner.

Faculty: The educators at SCA hold a minimum of Bachelor's degree, as well professional teaching certification through the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI). Many hold additional certifications in the state of Florida and professional organizations. The administration and instructional staff averages fifteen years of teaching experience.

Curriculum: SCA offers a challenging college preparatory academic program. The curriculum is selected to equip students to meet and exceed state and national standards. Academic classes are taught by caring teachers who challenge the students both intellectually and spiritually. A variety of secular and Christian curriculum is used to provide our teachers and students with the best possible resources, and Biblical values are integrated into all classes.
