Homecoming Event at SCA for High School Students 2020



1. What is Homecoming?

One of the Homecoming traditions at SCA is a homecoming event/banquet. The <u>Homecoming event</u> is open to all high school students, and it is a formal event to celebrate the week. It is on Saturday, October 31st from 6pm-8pm at Top Golf. Tickets will be sold for \$50. The event this year is at **Top Golf**. Students should arrive to check in between 5:30pm and 5:45pm. The event will start promptly at **6:00pm** and should conclude at 8:00pm. The address is 10690 Palm River Rd., Tampa. **Top Golf is divided into golfing bays that accommodate up to six people per bay. Students should be prepared to indicate their group preference at the time of ticket purchase. We will do our best to accommodate preferences, but cannot guarantee. Groups of more than six will be divided but placed in adjacent bays. Groups of less than six will be paired with another group(s).**

2. How much does it cost?

Tickets for homecoming are **\$50**. This includes food and event participation. The tickets will be sold from October $19^{th} - 23^{rd}$, in the high school office. Please pay with a <u>check</u> or <u>exact cash</u> only! Checks should be written to SCA. **Please remember you will need to indicate your group preference at the time of ticket purchase.**

3. Can parents attend the event?

Parents cannot attend the event. We will have plenty of SCA teachers and administrators present to chaperone.

4. How does my student get to the event?

The school does not provide transportation. Students may drive or be dropped off.

5. Who can attend the event?

Only SCA high school students can attend the event. All non-SCA students must fill out a guest form which requires both parents signatures and the signature of a school official for the guest. Non-SCA student dates must be under 21 years of age and of the opposite sex. Female non-SCA students must have dresses approved by Mrs. Shock. Dresses can be approved via sending pictures by email to sshock@scacrusaders.com. Dress guidelines can be found here. Students attending the event must abide by SCA standards.

6. What do students wear to the banquet?

The evening is a **semi-formal/formal** even, although dressy attire is also acceptable. Girls may wear knee length or floor length dresses. All female students, SCA students and non-SCA students, must have dresses approved. **Page 50-51** in the student handbook on the school website provides the detailed dress guidelines. Girls may approve dresses by sending a close up pictures of the dress from the front and back to Mrs. Shock at sshock@scacrusaders.com. Ladies must also submit the Dress
Checklist. Some dresses may need to be brought for approval if the picture cannot clearly show the dress. Boys must wear a suit, tuxedo, or shirt and tie. Students will be required to wear masks when they enter the event and in public spaces. The students will be divided into groups of six and assigned to a bay to golf,and they will eat in the bay as well. Students will not need to wear a mask in their own bay but my leave it on if they choose. Masks must be worn when students leave their bay for any reason.

7. Does the school provide parties for the students after Homecoming?

SCA does not sponsor any parties after the event. We are asking that parents use good judgement and refrain from having large gatherings or parties that could negatively impact our school community with a spread of COVID.

8. Does my student need a date to attend the banquet? Students do not need a date to attend the event. Many students choose to attend the banquet with a group of friends.
