To finalize acceptance, a **\$350.00** tuition deposit (maximum of **\$700.00** per family) is required. This deposit is applied to the May tuition. **(non-refundable or transferable)**

#### TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS:

**Full Payment:** There will be a 3% discount (tuition only) for those who pay the entire years tuition on or before **June 5** for the upcoming school year. If a child is withdrawn by the parent before December 31<sup>st</sup>, one half year's tuition will be refunded. If a parent withdraws a student after January 1<sup>st</sup>, no refund will be given.

**Ten Payments:** Your tuition is divided into ten equal payments. The 1<sup>st</sup> payment is due **July 1**, and the last payment is due on **May 1**. A student's grades and/or report card will be withheld until all fees and/or fines are paid. **There is no monthly tuition payment due in September.**

**ACADEMIC FEES:**

**iPAD IMPLEMENTATION PROGRAM:**

**All 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students are required to have an iPad for daily use.** Elementary students (K5-5<sup>th</sup>) will utilize school provided iPads.

**K5-5<sup>th</sup> grade: No Fee.** iPads are for in-school use only.

**6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade; \$120 per year per student.** The iPad is managed by SCA and will be turned in to the school at the end of each year in middle school. Students may take iPads home each day.

**9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade: \$250 per year per student for three years OR a one-time \$700 installment.** The iPad is managed by SCA and will be released to the student upon graduation or withdrawal from SCA (**once the balance of the iPad has been paid**). Students may take the iPad home each day and during the summer.

**TEXTBOOK POLICY:**

If a textbook is lost, stolen or damaged beyond usability, the student will be required to purchase another textbook from the school at its full replacement cost. All hardbound textbooks are the property of the school and must be covered at all times. The books must be returned without excessive wear at the completion of the school year or an additional fee will be assessed. If a textbook is missing for three consecutive class days it is to be considered lost and another textbook must be purchased from the school. Once the TAC fee has been assessed it is non-refundable.

**LATE CHARGES:**

Monthly tuition is to be paid in advance and is due and payable on the first day of each month. There will be a late charge of \$35 on any account when the account has not been paid by the 10<sup>th</sup> day of each month. If an account is past due for more than thirty (30) calendar days, the parent will be asked to remove the student from the school unless adequate arrangements have been made with the business office.

**WITHDRAWALS:**

Parents withdrawing students from SCA **MUST** initiate the process via the withdrawal form on the school website.

Students enrolled one day in a month (**INCLUDES JULY AND AUGUST**) will owe the full month's tuition. For a withdrawal procedure to be valid, parents must sign a withdrawal form indicating their intention of removing their child from school. No records are transferred if there is an outstanding balance due on the student's account.
