

# High School Supply/Summer Prep List



**2019-2020**

Getting ready for the school year in high school is multifaceted and requires some prep before and during the first few days of school. We recommend reviewing and working through the following areas to ensure a strong start.

## **Supplies**

Students will receive a syllabus for each class at the start of the school year. Teachers may have a few specific items that will be needed. Most classes require the following basic supplies:

Pens	Earbuds (Class use only)	iPad case (details below)
Pencils	Bookbag (no wheels)	Calculator*
Folder(s)	Paper	

\*Each math class will recommend a type of calculator based on the level of math.

Note: It is recommended to come to school the first day with a folder, paper and writing tool.

## **iPads**

The iPad is a major tool for the classroom. It is important that students come to school with their iPad fully charged each day. iPads must be in a case. Please see the list below for case sizing.

**All new 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> high school students** will receive an 10.5" iPad Air

**Returning 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> graders** have a 10.5" iPad Pro

**Returning 12<sup>th</sup> graders** have either a 9.7" or a 10.5" iPad Pro. (If you need to know your specific size, please email [iPadHelp@scacrusaders.com](mailto:iPadHelp@scacrusaders.com)).

*All high school iPads have 1st Generation Apple Pencil support. It is optional to purchase one.*

iPad applications and text books will be loaded on to the student iPads after the first day of school. Instructions will be given out on or before Friday, August 9th. *iBooks should be downloaded before class the following Monday.*
