## Tuition Payment Information

Tuition is payable monthly or yearly. Charges not included in tuition payments are field trips, PE and school uniforms, AP exams, dual-enrollment, and optional additional fees (see page 2).

### Tuition Payment Plans:

Pay In Full	3% discount if paid before the first day of school
10 - Month Plan	First payment in July 15, 2026 – Last payment in April 15, 2027
12 - Month Plan	First payment in July 15, 2026 – Last payment in June 15, 2027

## Continuous Enrollment

Once enrolled, your student will continue to auto-enroll each year until graduation or you choose to opt-out. A \$200 re-enrollment fee will be charged to your account February 1st. If choosing to opt-out for the following school year, families must complete the withdrawal form during the Opt-Out Window: December 5 – January 31 to avoid additional fees. A link to the withdrawal form will be emailed in December and must be submitted no later than January 31.

*Please note that students with unpaid balances or those not aligned with the school's mission and values may not be permitted to continue enrollment.*

## Scholarship/Assistance Options

Option	Explanation
Sibling Scholarship	A \$500 tuition discount is applied for each additional student enrolled.
Step-Up for Students	Parents must submit a current student(s) Award ID # to the SCA Business Office each year. Payment plans will be finalized once scholarship award amounts are confirmed by the D.O.E. <i>Please be prepared to cover the full annual tuition if legislative changes reduce or eliminate the program.</i>
FACTs Tuition Assistance	Limited financial assistance is available for families with verified financial need. Applicants must complete the required application, which has a \$45 application fee, with supporting documents. To apply, please follow the link in your family portal. Assistance does not cover full tuition. Awards are annual and require reapplication each year.

## Explanation

Online Application Fee	<b>\$200</b> per student, non refundable.
New Student Enrollment Fee	<b>\$200</b> fee to be paid upon acceptance after interview. This fee is waived for alumni and current SCA families
Late / Returned Payments	A fee of <b>\$35</b> will be charged for all late payments. <b>\$25</b> will be charged for all returned payments. <i>All tuition and fees must be current to access student records and transcripts.</i>
Suspension for Non-Payment	Students are <u>not</u> permitted to attend class when their accounts become 60 days delinquent. Students are subject to dismissal if their account is not brought current within one week of the suspension date. Students will be suspended only once during a school year for a delinquent account. A subsequent suspension for non-payment may result in the student's dismissal from SCA.
Re-enrollment Fee	\$200 charged on February 1 <sup>st</sup> , non-refundable.

## Explanation

4th Grade St. Augustine Trip	<b>\$475</b> per student
Grade Level Field Trips	<b>\$20 - \$100</b> fee to be paid prior to the field trip
8th Grade DC Trip	<b>\$2,300</b> (estimated). Broken down into monthly payments. Payments must be up-to-date to remain on the list to attend the trip.
Fine Arts Trip	<b>\$400 - \$700</b>
High School Missions Trip	Cost of the missions trip will be communicated by the missions leadership team during the school year.
AP/DE Classes	<b>\$175</b> charged per course
Senior Yearbook Ad	<b>\$225</b> Half Page <b>\$275</b> Full Page
Senior Trip	<b>\$2,500</b> (estimated). Actual cost of the trip will be communicated by the High School Office during the school year.

# Withdrawals

Students are considered enrolled for the entire academic year. Staffing and budget decisions are based on enrollment figures, and early withdrawals may leave openings that cannot be filled.

The final day to withdraw for the 2026–2027 school year is May 31, 2026.

Withdrawals submitted after this date will incur a **\$1,000 non-refundable fee per student** (K5–12th grade).

The full month's tuition is due for any month in which the student(s) attends school at least one day.  
All charges are **non-refundable** and due in full.

**Note:** Report cards, transcripts, and official records will not be released if there is an outstanding balance.

February 1, 2026 - May 31, 2026	<b>\$200</b> Reenrollment fee charged February 1 <sup>st</sup> is non refundable
After May 31, 2026	<b>\$1,000</b> Withdrawal Fee
Each month the student attends at least one day	<b>Full month's tuition</b> (in addition to the <b>\$1,000</b> Withdrawal Fee above)
