

Dress Approval Checklist

- _____ 1. My dress has straps or sleeves.
- _____ 2. My dress lays flat across the bust with no cleavage showing. (Remember there are tapes that can help with this.
- _____ 3. If the back of my dress is open, the opening stops at the base of my back.
- _____ 4. Any sheer panels in the front of back of my dress are lined. They are not lined with mesh, but actual fabric. (Note: Nude fabric is permissible to preserve the look of the dress)
- _____ 5. My dress (and/or any slit) is no more than two inches above the top of my knee.
- _____ 6. I understand that I must wear proper undergarments beneath my dress and that no bra straps can be showing.
- _____ 7. If my dress is two pieces, the pieces must either be sewn together or I must be able to raise my arms above my head without my stomach showing.
- _____ 8. I have submitted pictures of my dress to Mrs. Shock by email, or put it on for her in person for approval.

I understand that if I do not comply with the above guidelines for the Jr./Sr., I will be subject to disciplinary action. This may include detentions, suspensions and/or being asked to leave the activity immediately. Disciplinary actions will also be taken if I purposefully send misleading pictures that hide the fact that a dress does not meet dress code, or if I wear a dress that has not been approved.
