Hello 10th-12th grade students,

Many students aspire to join the National Honor Society beginning in 10th grade. Students who do not enter NHS in 10th grade have an opportunity to join in 11th or 12th grade. NHS induction occurs in April of each year. By March of 2019, eligible students will be invited to apply for NHS. Below is a reminder of the NHS entry requirements, if you wish to be considered for induction this spring.

SCA Requirements for National Honor Society

All policies are published in the SCA Student Handbook.

Policies governing the National Honor Society: The SCA Chapter of the National Honor Society seeks to recognize and bring together for common growth and interaction those students in the 10th through 12th grades who exhibit notable qualities in each of the following areas: scholarship, leadership, character and service. New members will be selected by the faculty and administration of Seffner Christian Academy each spring through a competitive selection process.

- Students who are eligible for NHS nomination must meet all of the following criteria:
 - Must have a 3.65 cumulative grade point average (weighted).
 - Must be taking at least two Honors, AP, or dual enrollment courses (or combination of these courses).
 - Must have no suspensions of any kind on their discipline record for the current school year.
 - Must have a minimum of 20 hours of community service documented in the guidance office within their high school career (summer after 8th grade – to current time). Please have hours turned into guidance office by February 1, 2019.
 - After eligibility is determined, eligible students will be given an application to apply for entry into the SCA chapter of NHS in the spring. The students must pass through the selection process successfully before being inducted into NHS.
