

OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

Hello SCA Students!

You have an opportunity to earn service hours and show the love of Christ this holiday season! High school students may earn up to 20 hours of community service for bringing in Christmas Child shoe boxes that meet the guidelines. For each box you turn in, you can earn 5 hours of service (with maximum earned of 20 hours). You may turn in as many boxes as you wish, but the maximum you can earn is 20 hours per year of participation.

How to participate and earn service hours:

1. Visit the Samaritan's Purse website to see directions on how to participate in Operation Christmas Child- [CLICK HERE](#). Turn in your boxes to the SCA front office at the designated drop-off spot. * **Note: Collection does not start until November 8.**
3. Print and complete the SCA Community Service Log (This form can be located in the "Guidance Resources" section of the school website or by [Clicking Here](#).) The front office staff can sign the log verifying you turned in the number of boxes/hours indicated on your form.
4. Once your form has been signed by the front office staff, turn in the service form to the guidance office. If I am not at my desk, you may put your form on my desk; once I have entered your service hours, I will send you an email notification to verify that your hours have been recorded.

ALL BOXES ARE DUE BY THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 15.

Remember: You will only receive credit for the boxes that you turn in... IF you complete and submit the proper service log. If you have any other questions about the Operation Christmas Child program, please contact the NHS Sponsor, an NHS member, or Mrs. Duncan, and they will be happy to answer those questions.
